The Felicia Sturzer Scholarship for WGSS majors was established to honor and reward academic achievement in Women, Gender, and Sexuality Studies. To be considered for this scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- You must have declared your WGSS major with the UTC Office of the Registrar. (Humanities: Women, Gender, and Sexuality Studies)
- You must have an overall GPA of at least 3.0.
- You must have a GPA of at least 3.5 in WGSS coursework
- You must have completed at least 15 semester hours of WGSS coursework by the end of the semester in which you are applying for the scholarship.

Additionally, the Women’s Studies Scholarship Committee may require an interview as part of the selection process, and their assessment of your responses to their questions during this interview may factor into the selection process.
