ETSU Online Course Required Prior to Application		
A least fifteen (15) credit-hours in basic human communication processes, non-disorders courses with at least two (2) credits in each of the following areas of speech, language, and hearing: the anatomic and physiologic bases; the physical and psychophysical bases; and the linguistic and psycholinguistic aspects. ETSU offers two semesters of pre-requisite coursework in speech-language pathology solely online. Register as a non-degree seeking special student, using the undergrad course. Then you would apply for the 2-year graduate program

UTC Credit for Online ETSU Courses		
CDIS courses are transferable to UTC for college credit, and are awarded to students as upper division general elective hours. These credits will apply to meet degree requirements only if students are majoring in areas with general elective hours available. Students should consult with their major advisor on how the CDIS courses will apply to their major specifically.		
Clinical Observation		
A log of at least 25 clinical observation hours under the supervision of a Speech-Language Pathologist who is ASHA certified, must be completed prior to application.
