Taking TSU Courses Before Applying to the Program

The Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology grants permission to take the prerequisite courses as a non-degree seeking student only after the applicant has gone through departmental advisement. Taking the prerequisite courses as a non-degree seeking student does not ensure or obligate acceptance into the Graduate Program in Speech and Hearing Science. A formal application for admission to the Graduate Program must be made through the Graduate School following procedures and policies indicated in the current Graduate Catalog.

UTC Credit for Online TSU Courses

SPTH courses are transferable to UTC for college credit, and are awarded to students as general elective hours. These credits will apply to meet degree requirements only if students are majoring in areas with general elective hours available. Students should consult with their major advisor on how the SPTH courses will apply to their major specifically.

GPA and Test Requirements
A minimum grade point average of 3.5 in a Bachelor's program is required. Applicants must also possess a Graduate Record Examination (GRE) of 146 minimum (verbal) and 140 minimum (quantitative) OR a minimum score on the Miller Analogies Test (MAT) of 380.
