

Students who have already completed a bachelor's degree in another discipline have the option to apply to the Accelerated BSN (ABSN) program. The following pre-requisite coursework must be completed with a C or better prior to applying to the School of Nursing, if not completed in the previous degree:

6 hours of writing & communication
 Psychology
 Statistics
 Chemistry with lab
 Human Anatomy (or A&P1) with lab
 Human Physiology (or A&P2) with lab
 Microbiology with lab.

Accelerated BSN Track: The ABSN only takes one year to complete so students should be prepared for the intensity and fast pace of the program. This program runs continuously with no semesters off.

Admission Criteria

Enrollment in the ABSN is limited and the number of qualified applicants may exceed the number of students who can be admitted. **Meeting minimum requirements for admission does not guarantee acceptance.** Completion of a bachelor's degree in another discipline prior to the posted application deadline.

- Completion of UTC Undergraduate Application (apply as a post baccalaureate student)
- Completion with a C or better (may have 2 in progress) the following pre-requisite coursework: 6 hours of writing & communication, Statistics, Chemistry with lab, Human Anatomy (or A&P1) with lab, Human Physiology (or A&P2) with lab, Psychology and Microbiology with lab.
- Pre-requisite coursework GPA of 2.75 (calculated on English Composition 1 and 2, Statistics, Chemistry with lab, Anatomy, Physiology, Psychology and Microbiology).
- Submit a current resume that includes:
 - Professional or work experience
 - Campus or community activities
 - Academic and other honors
 - Volunteer activities/work experience in health care
