CLEs are Important; Please Take Them Seriously!

- You are asked to evaluate each of your courses every semester
 - Each CLE should take about 5-10 minutes
- Student feedback helps faculty members evaluate teaching effectiveness and serves as part of their annual review
 - Helps instructors improve their quality of instruction
 - Helps UTC make decisions about faculty
- Individual and combined results are available to, and used by, the Provost, Dean, Department Head, and the instructor
- Responses and comments are anonymous unless you include your name in the comments
 - Instructors do not see any responses until after final grades have been submitted



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- Research has shown that unintentional bias can result in faculty who identify as women and people of color receiving less positive evaluations than others
- Your evaluation should focus on your learning experience (course content, method of delivery, assignments, textbook) rather than the personal characteristics of the instructor
